

The Present Perfect Simple

Regelmässige Verben:

to have/has + Grundform+ -ed

Beispiel:

I/you/we/they *have loved*
he/she/it *has loved*

Unregelmässige Verben:

to have/has + 3. Verbform

Beispiel:

I/you/we/they *have written*
he/she/it *has written*

Anwendung:

Das **Present Perfect Simple** drückt aus, dass eine Handlung **vor kurzem** stattfand und noch **Einfluss auf die Gegenwart** hat.

Beispiel: *She has cooked dinner. It's on the table now.*

Signalwörter: already, ever, just, never, not yet, so far, till now, up to now
